HOTEL TEATRO**

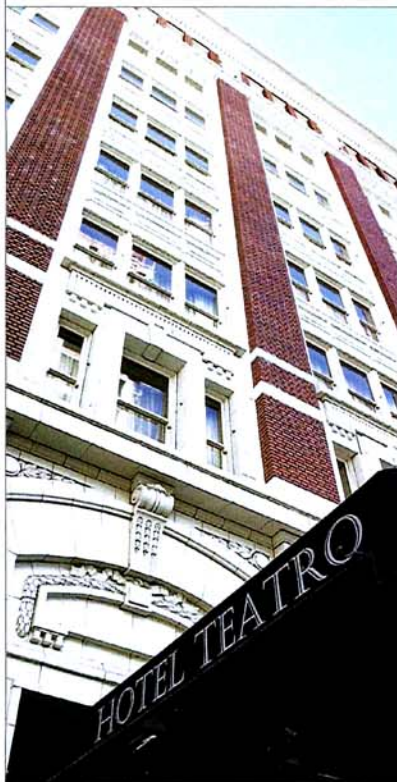

WINE AND DINE THE SEBASTIAN – VAIL

Executive chef Sergio Howland creates a farm-to-table menu of fresh, local, organic ingredients for Block 16, the signature restaurant at this luxury boutique resort. Since "block" refers to fruit from a specific vineyard lot, it's apropos that the dining destination produces its own limited-production private label wine, under the direction of winemaker Bryan Page—a cabernet sauvignon with notes of Europe and Napa Valley. Artist Manuel Felguérez—responsible for sculptures and paintings seen throughout the hotel—created a special label for the bottle. thesebastianvail.com
