In his role as president for the company, David Burden oversees the development, sales and marketing of the company's projects.

Over the last 25 years, Burden has also acted as a development partner at the Roaring Fork Club, a private golf and fishing club with a Jack Nicklaus golf course located in Basalt, Colorado and as principal in the Melrose Company of Hilton Head Island, where he was responsible for the marketing and development of Indigo Run, a 1,700-acre country club community with two Jack Nicklaus courses.
