# Winter Wonderland

A Colorado getaway beckons with new happenings at some of our favorite ski resorts.

## CRESTED BUTTE

Last February, **Crested Butte Mountain Resort** opened approximately 50 acres of skiing in an extreme terrain area known as Teo 2. The area sits within the resort's current ski area boundary, and, with a new egress road and snow safety work completed, Teo 2 will be ready in time for this winter season.

The new **Umbrella Bar at Ten Peaks**, located at Crested Butte Mountain Resort, makes its debut this ski season. It will feature glass walls, a 35-foot-diameter retractable umbrella roof and a 2,400-square-foot deck for outdoor seating. With 360-degree views, this bar will be one of the most picturesque in Colorado ski country. Menu offerings will include fish tacos, grilled panini sandwiches and gourmet sausages.

## BRECKENRIDGE

Get your best gal pals together this winter season for Breckenridge Ski Resort's **Women's Ski Week**, taking place Feb. 14 to 22. Enjoy tailored ski and snowboard lessons, dubbed Ladies First Ultimate 4 Ski Lessons, designed for no more than four participants per



class. Other highlights of the week include gear demos; Women & Wine Lessons (featuring a half-day ski lesson for women only, with wine pairings at the Living Room); a screening of *Pretty Faces* (the first ski movie to feature solely women athletes); and more.
